






3 For I passed on to you as most important



1. The Need for Our Encouragement


13 Paul and his companions set sail from Paphos and came to Perga in Pamphylia, but John left them and went back to Jerusalem. 14 They continued their journey from Perga and reached Pisidian Antioch. On the Sabbath day they went into the synagogue and sat down. 15 After the reading of the Law and the Prophets, the leaders of the synagogue sent word to them, saying, ***“Brothers, if you have any word of encouragement for the people, you can speak.”***

2. The Source of Our Encouragement


30 But God raised him from the dead, 31 and he appeared for many days to those who came up with him from Galilee to Jerusalem, who are now his witnesses to the people. 32 And we ourselves proclaim to you **the good news** of the promise that was made to our ancestors. 33 God has fulfilled this for us, their children, by raising up Jesus, as it is written...

3. The Fulfillment of Our Encouragement

38 Let it be known to you therefore, brothers, that through this man forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you, 39 and by him everyone who believes is freed from everything from which you could not be freed by the law of Moses.




