Communion With Whom? 1 Corinthians 10:14-22 Pastor Jose Prado 09/02/2018

Proposition: Flee from the Compromise of Idolatry in light of your **Communion with Christ.**

14 So then, my dear friends, flee from idolatry.

Question: What is the big deal with idolatry if idols are nothing in this World?

Answer: You can't have communion with God and compromise at the same time!

1. The Glory of Communion

16 The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a sharing in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a sharing in the body of Christ?

Why is The **Communion Table** so Glorious? (Two Reasons)

a. Union with Christ

16 The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a sharing in the blood of Christ?The bread that we break, is it not a sharing in the body of Christ?

b. Union with One Another

17 Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, since all of us share the one bread.

2. The Gravity of Compromise

18 Consider the people of Israel. Do not those who eat the sacrifices participate in the altar?

Why is idolatry so grievous? (Two Reasons)

a. Participating with Demons

19 What am I saying then? That food sacrificed to idols is anything, or that an idol is anything? 20 No, but I do say that what they sacrifice, they sacrifice to demons and not to God. I do not want you to be participants with demons!

b. Provoking The Father's Heart

21 You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons. You cannot share in the Lord's table and the table of demons. 22 Or are we provoking the Lord to jealousy? Are we stronger than he?

Whom will you be united to today? God or Demons?
