John 13

1. I will choose to serve... even when it's hardest to love.

John 13:1

Now before the Feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that his hour had come to depart out of this world to the Father, having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end.

2. I will choose to serve... even when it has become personal and I feel betrayed.

3. I will choose to serve... as a form of action, not an emotion.

Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands (that He is God), and that he had come from God and was going back to God, 4 rose from supper. He laid aside his outer garments, and taking a towel, tied it around his waist. 5 Then he poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel that was wrapped around him.
